- Contractors selected on a competitive basis



Serve on a Project Panel!

* Give back to industry * Network * Be on cutting edge of research

- Each project has a panel
- First step is nomination
- Staff form panel based on:
 - Topic
 - Perspectives/disciplines
 - Diversity of geography, airport size, gender, ethnicity, career stage
- Three in-person meetings (we reimburse travel)
 - Define scope/objective
 - Select contractor
 - Meeting with contractor
- Monitor progress/provide feedback on deliverables





Submit a Problem Statement (Research Idea)!

* If you have a problem, others likely do, too!


- Concise 1-2 page justification for research
- Provide:
 - Title (10 words or fewer)
 - Background (why research is needed)
 - Objective (what product(s) will be produced)
 - Research approach (general steps, if known)
 - Cost estimate (if possible)
 - Related research (to avoid overlap with other studies)





Contribute to ACRP Research!

* The quality of our research is related to contributions of practitioners







Submit a Proposal To Do Research!

* Get paid to do research * Be recognized as industry leader

- Concise (60 pages)
- Responsive to RFP
- Primary audience = Airports
- Clear, detailed research approach
- Balance demonstration of expertise with recognizing research need
- Meaningful diversity, equity, and inclusion
- Remember RFP special notes
- Panel roster available
